






# Cultivating Global Competencies in Tomorrow's Leaders: A Teacher's Guide to Student Preparation

The panel will feature speakers from Law Firms, General Counsel and Academia, aiming to elucidate the essential competencies required for students; guiding educators on how to facilitate the development of these competencies in students. #### Legal Education in the 21st Century: Role of Law Teachers

The session aims to explore the evolving landscape of legal education, anticipating its trajectory over the next five years, and emphasizing the pivotal role of law teachers in preparing for increasing competition and globalization. Special attention will be given to the impact of the General Agreement on Trade in Services (GATS) under the World Trade Organization (WTO) on legal education.
